AN INTRODUCTION

THE SUGGESSFUL

LIFE

Success in the Christian life is not an accident. It is a direct result of living in harmony with the basic principles of life set forth in Scripture.

JESUS CHRIST'S FIRST STAFF MEETING

The underlying principles to Jesus Christ's first words to his disciples are the keys to becoming a successful person. The average person today is not living nor experiencing a meaningful and purposeful life. Instead, there are conflicts in practically every relationship of his life (e.g. God, parents, partner, friends, employer, children).

A HAPPY & SUCCESSFUL LIFE IS POSSIBLE!

Jesus said, "I am come that they might have life and that they might have it more abundantly." John 10:10b

He also said, "Whoso drinketh of the water that I give him, out of his innermost being shall flow rivers of living water."

John 4:4

David said of the Lord, "Thou hast made known to me the ways of life; thou shalt make me full of joy with thy countenance." Acts 2:28

AN "INWARD IDEAL"

Real outward success in a person's life is a by-product of inner achievement. God is seeking to develop an "inward ideal" that is comprised of eight qualities. As an individual applies the basic principles of Scripture to his life, these qualities are developed from within. The result is a transformed life that reflects the love of Jesus Christ in his words, attitudes and actions.

RELATIVE OR ABSOLUTE?

Jesus Christ wants to relive His life all over again through us. To the degree that we respond to God, people and the circumstances around us in the same way Jesus Christ would have responded to them, we become more like Him!

THE BASIC ISSUE IS NOT WHAT IS HAPPENING TO ME BUT HOW I RESPOND TO WHAT GOD ALREADY KNEW WOULD HAPPEN TO ME.

If I react to my situations based on how I think or how I feel

the result is conflicts.

If I respond to the situation from -God's point of view

the result is a conformity to the image of Jesus Christ.

Romans 8: 28 - 29:

"For we know that all things work together for the good to them who love God . . .

. . . that we might be conformed to the image of His Son."

Jesus Christ called his disciples to a NEW WAY OF LIFE in which the underlying principles of the Beatitudes are NOT OPTIONAL but are ABSOLUTE. This is true for every individual who will follow Him and who wants to be completely successful as a Christian!

A MEANINGFUL RELATIONSHIP WITH GOD

MAN CAN ONLY GIVE PHYSICAL LIFE -

BUT ONLY GOD CAN GIVE SPIRITUAL LIFE!

It is easy to purpose to follow Jesus Christ as a way of life as long as it is convenient and all goes well. But it is entirely another matter when, to acknowledge Him as Savior and Lord (boss) of my life means to obey Him regardless of the circumstances. This cannot be done without the power of God in my life.

GOD'S PLAN :

We aren't saved from sin's grasp by knowing (intellectual knowledge) the commandments of God, because we can't and don't keep them . . .

But God put into effect a different plan to save us. He sent His own Son in a human body like ours - except that ours is sinful and destroyed sin's control over us by giving Himself as a sacrifice for sins.

So now we can obey God's laws if we follow after the Holy Spirit and no longer obey the old evil nature within us.



THREE WORLDS

A person's life is composed of three parts:

a spirit (spiritual), soul (psychological),
and body (physical). These operate on
three independent systems, yet are interrelated
and have a significant relationship to one
another.

GOD'S ORDER:

 A relationship with Him in which His Word and principles are the foundation and basis for living.

- The mind, emotions and will are related to God's thought patterns thus rebuilding our minds, emotions and will to think His thoughts, refocus on His emotions and make decisions based on His Word.
- The physical is brought into under control of the spiritual principles; the result is a proper balance and freedom which enables the person to live in harmony with God's principles. The actions and attitudes communicate inner motivation of the Holy Spirit. (Galatians 5:21,22)

VIOLATING GOD'S ORDER

Most people are unaware there is a force within each human being which God calls a "LOWER NATURE." To ignore the God-shaped vacuum within that causes a man to search for meaning and purpose, and to seek instead to fill the life with "what I want" or to react to life because this is "what I think," or "how I feel," will result in experiencing the consequences of violating God's spiritual order. These frustrations are clearly described by the Apostle Paul in Romans 7:15-25.

VIOLATED LAWS

A person naturally gives much attention to the physical and psychological areas of his life. However, the most essential aspect of a man, his spiritual life, has been neglected. Before he realizes it, a deterioration of his spiritual life results in broken lives, marriages and families.

CONSEQUENCES WHEN PHYSICAL LAWS ARE VIOLATED:

There are physical laws which govern the universe as well as the physical life of the individual.

IT MATTERS NOT WHETHER YOU KNOW THEM, THE CONSEQUENCES ARE THE SAME! Whether a person has a degree in physics or knows nothing of the law of gravity, if he willfully or accidentally violates gravity from the top of a 20 story building, the same consequences result.

In the same manner, if a person neglects to feed his body food, the result will be illness; if he continues to neglect the physical law that a body needs food, death will be the consequence.

CONSEQUENCES WHEN PSYCHOLOGICAL LAWS ARE VIOLATED:

THERE IS MORE
THAN ONE LOGICAL
WAY TO DEAL WITH
A SUBJECT OR
SITUATION.

A person has basic intellectual and emotional needs as well as the ability to make the right decisions for a successful life. The mind calls for a "logical" approach and explanation imrelating to life. Though a specific approach and conclusion may seem right at the time when confronted with a situation, if the insight is contrary to God's solution to the problem the ultimate results will manifest themselves in mental confusion, emotional disorders, wrong decisions.

AN EXAMPLE OF WRONG LOGIC evidenced in many lives: I reason, "God made everything. He has allowed everything to happen. There are some things that I wish hadn't happened to me. Therefore, I can't trust God with my whole life."

CONSEQUENCES WHEN SPIRITUAL LAWS ARE VIOLATED:

A foundational principle of God's Word is that an individual is personally responsible for his thoughts, attitudes and actions. Society today has deceived a person into thinking that the "problems" he is experiencing are the fault of others who were the "cause" of the difficulty. Society's assumption is that if the person understands (mentally) why he is acting the way he is then hopefully he will be able to cope emotionally with the situation and make a better decision next time.

A person will say "I know (intellectually) I'm bitter, but I can't get rid of it !" The Scriptures point out - "a wounded spirit, who can bear it?"

THE FOLLOWING PAGES EXPLAIN AND ILLUSTRATE THE BASIC SPIRITUAL PRINCIPLES UPON WHICH A SUCCESSFUL LIFE IS BUILT SO THAT WE MIGHT ACCOMPLISH OUR ULTIMATE GOAL:

"We are asking God THAT YOU MAY SEE THINGS, AS IT WERE, FROM HIS POINT OF VIEW by being given spiritual insight and understanding. We also pray that your outward lives, which men see, may bring credit to your master's name, and that you may bring joy to his heart by bearing genuine Christian fruit, and that your knowledge of God may grow yet deeper. As you live this new life, we pray that you will be strengthened from God's boundless resources, so that you will find yourselves able to pass through any experience and endure it with joy. You will even be able to thank God in the midst of pain and distress because you are privileged to share the lot of those who are living in the light."
