Dear Friends,

I have been reading through my yearly Bible plan, and I just finished Ruth. As I was praying about what to write, I couldn't get away from the idea of Ruth, an outcast, being transported into the royal family line of Jesus by grace. She was from Moab. God had cursed her people in Deut. 23:3, but due to her faithfulness to Naomi and God's sovereign plan, she became a "princess" and inherited a life of blessing.

*"Oh give thanks to the Lord; call upon his name; make known his deeds among the peoples! Sing to him, sing praises to him; tell of all his wondrous works!"*

If we are truly honest with ourselves, we are all "Ruths." We have all been broken from hurts, disaster, and sin. Loss is a topic that connects all of us on a human level. We are told in one of the most quoted verses by Jesus that we are to "store up for ourselves treasures in heaven" (Matt. 6:20a NIV). Sharing how God takes our sufferings in life and turns them into good is one of those "treasures in heaven". Ruth most likely had no idea of what was in her future, as it is for us. We tend to imagine the purest form of our own futures without thorns or hardships, but often those life changing events bring us closer to God than we could have ever imagined, and as a result, we can "*make known his deeds among the peoples! Sing praises to him...*" (Ps. 105:1,2 ESV).

He had an addiction that had lasted for years, and a hidden sin that was affecting himself, his family, and work. He was **desperate**. He wanted change, but didn't know how. He found out about BRM from a friend who had worked with Dr. Logan, and during the week long counseling, "Jason" started experiencing more and more freedom in Christ. He was exposing the darkness that the enemy had been using to keep him from the light. Freedom comes from God as a response to being obedient to Him through much repentance and honesty. "Jason" started to see this. I had shared with him this message by Rev. Jeff Pokone on freedom from addictions. The Reverend says that 'godly sorrow means that my heart feels the same way God feels about the sin, but worldly sorrow is that I am sorry I got caught, painful circumstances, financial loss, or the loss of my wife or kids'.

God changed Ruth; He has changed me, and I know He can change you. It does take courage, as I saw in "Jason's" life. He was open and honest. He had some difficult conversations with his wife and children, but he is experiencing God changing his heart. I pray that you would ask God to search you and see if there is any hidden areas in your heart that need to be exposed to the Light of Truth. Remember, the enemy loves secrets because they keep us bound in darkness, but may we all be like Ruth, and be obedient to God as she was to Naomi. "Jason" gave us permission to share his testimony below of God setting him free:

"I came to BRM in a state of helplessness. I was trapped in a sexual sin that was destroying me, my family, my relationships, and my business. I am a Christian, but I had an evil presence inside of me that blocked any relationship with God. I was spiritually empty and was in bondage. This had been going on for over 20 years. With a repentant heart, God used BRM to help lead me out of darkness and into the light. Instead of being "counseled" I was **disciplined** in true Biblical format.
